1. Autograph page in Camp Book: Six schools: 1 boy, 1 girl, 1 Adult from each school, and 2 Camp Erdman Counselors.
2. Complete pages in Camp Book after the map of camp grounds. Write so it is readable. Explain your answers completely and give assessment of the activity where asked.
3. A written report on your camp experience:
 - **2-pages typed with cover page or 3-pages hand-written in pen with cover page.
 - ** DO not write it in "diary" form, activity by activity from beginning of day to the end of day.
 - ** Use complete sentences, spelling, and paragraph construction.
 - ** Provide a look at camp with feelings and how your group worked together. Keep the same idea in the paragraph, e.g., one paragraph could talk about all KP activity you experienced, another paragraph could share your freetime activity, or mountain hike.
4. Pictures will not give you a better grade for the written report. If you feel it may enhance your explanations, please feel free to include them.
