Dear parents of Fifth graders at Our Savior Lutheran:

Today your fifth grader should be bringing home a DARE shirt that was purchased for us by the PTF. Most of our smaller students had to take a small adult shirt as they only come in adult sizes. Please wash it inside out and in cold water the first few times.

Each student is required to write a thank you note to the PTF, not only thanking them for their shirt and certificate folder, but should include a few sentences about what they learned during the DARE program.

Please mark your calendars and plan to attend DARE graduation on May 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM in the church. It is important that the students wear their DARE shirt with uniform shorts that evening. We will be out in an hour. Each student should consider bringing a lei for Officer Montgomery that night or for DARE DAY at UH on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. The class will have a lei for Officer Montgomery that will be officially presented during the program.

This week each student should be seriously working on a report on "Taking a Pledge to stay Drug Free". It is to be completed in good writing form by Monday, April 30<sup>th</sup>. The minimum is 1 1/2 pages hand-written or 1 page typed with standard margins and font of 12 or 14. There is a minimum of 4 paragraphs complete with ideas on what they have learned and how they plan to use this information in their future years. This is part of their Science grade. This week they were allowed to take their book home; it must return to school next week as it too is graded.

We will need drivers to get to UH DARE DAY on May 22<sup>nd</sup>. The parent drivers may stay with us for the 3 + hours or just return to the parking garage to pick us up. We leave school at 8 AM and leave UH after 11:30 AM. The program starts at 9 AM and schools are assigned a dismissal time. Since we are driving, we leave soon after 11:30 AM.
