

Grade 4 Class Rules

1. Be here.
2. Be on time.
3. Be prepared.
4. Be healthy.
5. Be polite and kind to others.
6. Be responsible.
7. Be respectful.
8. Be a good helper.
9. Be a good listener/pay attention/follow directions.
10. Keep hands and feet to yourself.
11. Raise your hand if you have any questions/comments.
12. Do your BEST work, do NEAT work and remember to DOUBLE CHECK and PROOFREAD for errors BEFORE turning assignment in!
13. No talking when the teacher is talking (you should Be LISTENING)!
14. Respect each others personal space whether at desks, in line, sitting in chapel, on the bus etc.
15. Use the bathroom BEFORE school, during first and second recesses, and after eating lunch to minimize the need to go during instructional/work time.
16. Unload all necessary items from backpack needed for the day (homework, textbooks, workbooks, binder, signed tests, agendas, library books that are due, etc. Let's practice good habits.
17. After backpacks are thoroughly unpacked, use the Bathroom, get a drink/fill water bottles, sharpen 3 Regular pencils & 2 red pencils, ask questions, turn in notes from home in top tray on my desk, turn in library books that may be due, then finally check the board for directions/morning work, and get started QUICKLY and QUIETLY! It may include journal writing with a listed topic or topic of your choice, review for upcoming quizzes/tests, note-taking, reading for the Accelerated Reading program/Book It program, pleasure reading of your choosing or a specific activity.

Class Discipline

Depending on severity of problem or number of repeat occurrences, student may get a first and or second warning. After the second or third warning, student may do any of the following or a combination. They may be asked to:

- 1) write in their SPIN (student, parent, information notebook).
- 2) sit out during recess (for a portion of or all of it) to think and focus on what they did wrong, and think of what they're going to do to correct the problem, so hopefully they've learned a lesson and would be able to prevent it from happening again.
- 3) work through problems (with another/other students) using conflict resolution steps.
- 4) or call to parent
- 5) or sent to the Principal.

Late homework/assignments/projects

Late work will not be tolerated, except with a valid excuse (deemed valid by the teacher). Student will receive a "0" if not turned in, when due.

SPIN – Student – Parent – Information – Notebook

Student will write down date, and a brief but specific explanation to parents, notifying parents of misbehavior or non-completion of homework, assignments, projects or involvement of a negative situation/problem.
