## STARBASE ATLANTIS INFORMATION

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To: Fifth Grade Parents at OSLS

DATE: Sept. 5, 2007

There are many forms to fill out and submit for our classroom and parent volunteers to be ready to attend STARBASE ATLANTIS the day we return from Intercession, Oct. 15<sup>th</sup>. Please look over everything carefully and meet all deadlines.

**The last 3 pages of the stapled forms from STARBASE ATLANTIS must be returned to me by Sept. 18<sup>th</sup>.** Please read through them with your child. **They** also must sign on the appropriate line. Make sure they sign a readable first and last name in cursive using blue or black ink.

The first two pages explain what will be happening during our week. The rules are specific for discipline. Read it orally with your child. During the day we are busy from 8:30 AM to 1:30 PM with only 1/2 hr. lunchtime and a morning bathroom break. Our attending dates again are Oct. 15, 16, 17, 18, & 19<sup>th</sup>. There will be a graduation ceremony and launching of rockets on that Friday afternoon. More information will be sent home on that event. It is a Kodak moment! Having a military sticker will get you on base quickly. We urge car pools for that afternoon.

**Dress** for that week will be a shirt with sleeves, maybe long sleeves, and either uniform shorts or any appropriate long pants, including neat looking blue jeans. Many activities will be on the floor. The temperature was comfortable last year, but they may turn down the temperature for class making it colder. Closed shoes with shoestrings or Velcro are to be worn. No shoes that come off easily will be allowed. This is also the appropriate attire for adults; bring a jacket as adults sit more.

**A STARBASE ATLANTIS T-shirt will be worn over their regular clothing. It will stay at school after each day. No one is admitted without his or her T-shirt on daily. The students have a mandatory meeting Sept. 26<sup>th</sup> with Starbase Staff in our classroom.**

**A small bag for lunch/drink** is the only thing students bring to class. Their team must be able to put all their lunches into a drawer; so, no large coolers. Drinks must be plastic containers with a screw lid. Juice cans are OK, but no soda. Any additional water container must follow the rule of a screw lid plus a wrap around it to prevent water condensation being left behind.

**Each day we need 3 adults** to attend to assist us in behavior control and activities. You, too, need a call sign and must follow the dress code. In addition, no cell phones "on" are allowed in the classroom. My earlier sign-up sheet didn't specify whether you were driving or attending each day. So, now I need specific parent or other family adult to sign-up to attend. You can do one day or all five days. Transportation will be available to those adults that are not military.
